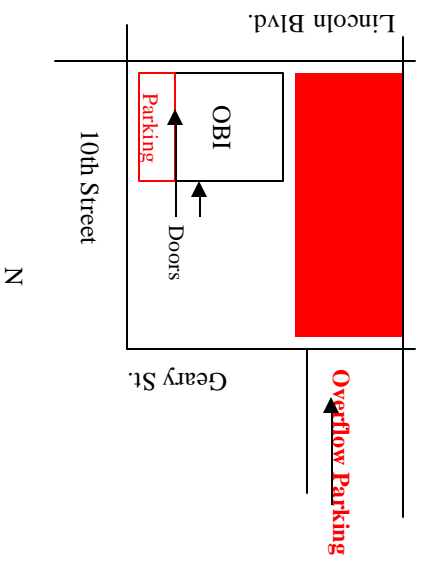


DATE	CONFERENCE TITLE	EVENT DESCRIPTION
January 14	ISBT 128 for Cellular Products, Tissues, Derivatives and Beyond	Review the status of ISBT 128 implementation in the fields of cellular therapy, tissue transplantation and derivatives worldwide. Tools available to simplify the selection of product codes will be demonstrated. Products for NMDR will be presented.
February 11	Serologic Case Studies	Covers the multiple testing methods that are in wide-spread use. Participants will be able to evaluate the potential strengths and pitfalls of each.
March 18	Assays: Back to Basics	Addresses some of the assays commonly performed in most cell therapy labs including progenitor cell assay, trypan blue, and automated and manual cell counting.
May 20	Transfusion Safety and Positive Patient ID at the Bedside <i>(may be of interest to nurses)</i>	Explores all aspects of providing a safe transfusion to a patient with the use of positive patient ID. Discusses mechanisms and technology available for positive ID.
June 3	Hematology for Blood Bankers	After a basic review of the different tests conducted in hematology, the indications for blood products will be presented.
November 18	RBC Genotyping—Molecular Testing	Describes the structure and function of molecules that carry red cell antigens and what is being uncovered relative to the incidence of variants in different populations.
