One in eight women will develop breast cancer in her lifetime. During chemotherapy and radiation both cancer cells and healthy cells are destroyed, so patients may need blood and platelet transfusions to prevent bleeding or to fight infections. When donors open their arms to patients in need, they are not only doing a good deed – they are extending a lifeline to neighbors, loved ones and friends.

Any donor who gives blood, platelets or plasma April 1 to May 22 at OBI Tulsa Center or at an area mobile drive can elect to forgo the normal t-shirt incentive (a \$4 value) in favor of having OBI make a contribution to underwrite programs at Susan G. Komen for the Cure® - Tulsa. OBI needs your help to ensure necessary blood products are available on-demand for the daughters, mothers and grandmothers in our community who are battling breast cancer right now.
